



Ayodhya priest invites Rahul Gandhi to stay in Hanumangarhi temple

A mahant at the Hanumangarhi Mandir here on Monday invited Congress leader Rahul Gandhi to stay on the temple premises after he vacates the government bungalow allotted to him as Member of Parliament.

Gandhi was recently served a notice to vacate

the bungalow following his disqualification from Lok Sabha on being convicted by a Gujarat court in a criminal defamation case and awarded a two—year sentence.

The "offer" was interpreted by some as an expression of support for the Congress from a mahant of a temple in a BJP bastion.

"We, the seers of

Ayodhya, welcome Rahul Gandhi to this pious city, we offer him our place to reside," priest Sanjay Das said.

Mahant Sanjay Das is heir to the prestigious seat of Mahant Gyan Das, the elderly seer of Hanumangarhi. Sanjay Das is also the national president of the Sankat Mochan Sena.

Talking to PTI, Das

said if Gandhi wants to come and live in the Hanumangarhi campus, he is most welcome.

"Rahul Gandhi must come to Ayodhya and visit Hanumangarhi and offer prayers here. There are many such ashrams in the campus area of Hanumangarhi, he should come and stay in our ashram, we will be happy," he added.

Rahul Gandhils disqualification a campaign issue in poll-bound Karnataka, says Congress leader Veerappa Moily

The disqualification of Rahul Gandhi as a Lok Sabha member would be a campaign issue for the Congress in the Assembly elections in Karnataka and it would contribute to the defeat of the BJP government in the state, senior party leader M Veerappa Moily said on Monday.

In an interview with PTI, the former Karnataka chief minister said there is a "groundswell" of support for the Congress in the state, and his partyls campaign on corruption issues have worked, while the BJP is facing a "strong, anti—incumbency wave".

"Definitely, it (Congress leader Rahul Gandhils disqualification following his conviction and sentencing by a Surat court) will be a campaign issue," the former



Union minister said

Asked if the disqualification issue would serve to the "political advantage" of the Congress in the poll—bound state, Moily said: "Itls everywhere in the country;


after all, it (the issue) shows that itls the peak of vendetta politics". He said the issue would create a sympathy wave in part for the Congress becoming "one of the factors that will be responsible

for the fall of the BJP". Moily said his partyls campaign is far more aggressive than the ruling BJP, which is concentrating more on the Narendra Modi—Amit Shah image, adding that the Congress would also focus on "exposing" the BJP and the Narendra Modi—led government and their "revengeful politics".


He alleged that the BJP government has "messed up" the reservation issue in Karnataka.

Moily was referring to the Basavaraj Bommai governmentls recent decision on scrapping four per cent reservation for Muslims within the OBC category and earmarking an additional two per cent each to Vokkaliga and Veerashaiva—Lingayat communities and creating four sub—categories to introduce internal quota for different Dalit communities under the SC category.

As Rahul Gandhi leaves for Surat to appeal against conviction, Congress workers gather in support

As Congress leader and Wayanad MP Rahul Gandhi readied to land in Surat Monday along with his sister and party general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, party workers and leaders from across the state gathered in solidarity in the city. Congress leaders from other




districts who are in Surat alleged the Gujarat Police, which have deployed its personnel in large numbers in and around the city, were "preventing" them from entering. Former Congress MLA
