Visited the place where many people died in Shirur

Visited the place where many people died in Shirur, Ankola Taluk, Uttara Kannada district, inspected the rescue operation. There is a dangerous hill on the left side of the road which is covered under the mud. There is a river Gangavali flowing in the right side. It is very challenging to find lives stuck under the soil in continuous pouring rains. S operating in a very dangerous situation. D. R. F and N. D. R. Really commendable for the performance of the F staff. Four teams are operating using radar technology to detect those who may be trapped under a hillside. Four more teams operating inside the river on the other side. Revenue Minister Krishna Biregowda has



been standing at the place and taking care of the charge for several days. Operation space and mud road is also likely to collapse. So I warned that the staff involved in the rescue operations are extremely vigilant about this. The hillside site is kinda an island.

Gangavali river is flowing around. Half collapsed hill stands in between. Thus I have suggested to get informed from top-level experts about the risks and challenges that may arise during operation and seek essential technology help. Revenue Minister

Krishna Bairegowda, District Incharge Minister Mankala Vaidya, Ex Minister R. V. Deshpande, legislator Satish Sail, L, the main secretary of the government. K. Senior officer and staff of revenue department along with Ateeq, Shalini Rajneesh were on the spot.

Conducted a progress review meeting of relief work of flood affected areas

Conducted a progress review meeting of relief work of flood affected areas with senior government officers and district level officers at Karwar District Panchayat Hall, gave some important instructions. Submit immediate damage report to provide compensation for loss of agriculture and horticulture crops due to rain. Make the final decision on providing permanent relief to victims affected by the water that exits Kadra dam. Urgent compensation should be given to the loss of life due to rain disaster and flood. Electric poles installed on Coastal line, wires repair and replacement where needed. National highway work in the district has not been completed. R. Why are B compa-

nies collecting toll? This is not right. Even though the work is supposed to be completed in 2016, you are misinforming the central ministers and the state government about this work without being concluded till now. I will write a letter to the Central Highway Minister about this. The district administration should take all precautionary measures to prevent any threat including hillslides. Village level task force committees should be formed in villages in dangerous areas of the district and informed the district administration about the situation there. All officers in the district should work to make people trust officers by responding to public issues immediately.
