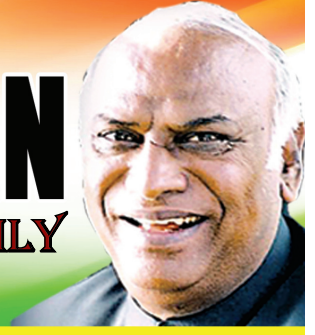

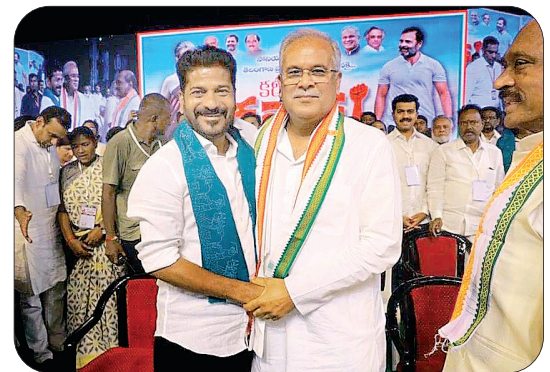




Go Get Education
