Thousands of Congressmen, under the leadership of Bihar Congress President Dr Akhilesh Prasad Singh, along with all the parties of the All India Alliance, took out a protest march from Income Tax roundabout to Dakbungla crossing, raising loud slogans against the government, against the deteriorating law and order situation in Bihar and warned the NDA government of the state. Bihar Congress President Dr Akhilesh Prasad Singh, who is leading this protest march, said that the intentions of criminals in the state have reached the seventh sky. Bihar government chief Nitish Kumar has mortgaged Bihar to criminals. Crimes, murders, robbery, dacoity and rapes are happening in any district in broad daylight and the police department is sitting idle. The Chief Minister has handed over the state to corrupt officials in Bihar, the brunt of which has to be borne by the common people. A protest march has been taken out against the kind of law and order that has been created in Bihar. In which all the allies of the Grand Alliance have come out on the streets strongly. The people of the entire state have come to know that Nitish Kumar has become helpless. The government is being run in this state under proxy, in which the government is being run by officials and four—five leaders keeping the power away from the hands of Nitish Kumar.
