Mr. Yadav said that for years this country is known all over the world for its Ganga—Jamni tehzeeb. In such a situation, the conspiracy of the

In protest against the atrocities on Dalits and Mahadalits in Bihar and other important demands, Bihar Pradesh Congress Sevadal Young Brigade took out a march to Raj Bhavan on Monday. This march was led by Dr. Sanjay.

The objective of the march was to restore 65% reservation in Bihar again, to restore the appointment of Chowkidar and Dafadar as before. Along with this, a demand was also raised to protest against suppressing the voice of Dalits and to expose the Agniveer and NEET scam.

During the march, Dr. Sanjay said, Stop suppressing the voice of Dalits! Expose the Agniveer and NEET scam! We will fight and win! We will not stop! The



voice of the people will not be suppressed. During the Rajbhawan march, the police tried to stop the march, but the arrest attempt failed amid heavy protests. The police tried unsuccessfully to arrest prominent leaders including Dr. Sanjay. Despite this, the delegation submitted a memorandum to the Governor. Bihar Pradesh Congress President Dr. Akhilesh

Prasad Singh praised all the workers for making this march successful and said that our fight is for justice and equality. We will continue to struggle for our rights.
